From the Rumour Mill

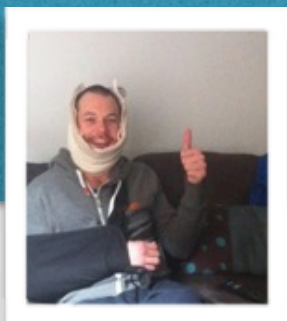
* I wonder which senior player recently asked for 'two legs' as his guard and then got bowled around his legs??
